Member Profile: Dan Rutan

Dan grew up in a small town in Illinois and attended Eastern Illinois University where he earned a degree in Botany, Fine Arts and Business. In high school he enjoyed hobbies of gardening, singing, and playing saxophone in marching band.

After graduating, he enlisted in the Air Force and trained in Amarillo Texas. He was stationed at Edwards Air Force base in California and then served 18 months on Okinawa during the Viet Nam war.

After 4 years in the Air Force Dan moved to Santa Cruz and interviewed as a management trainee at JC Penny on Pacific Avenue. They were happy to hire him with the only condition being that he shave off his mustache! In spite of Santa Cruz (1969) being home to many hairy hippies at the time, he acquiesced in order to obtain the position.

Dan's next jobs were with his brother's construction company, then with the Credit Bureau of Santa Cruz where he worked in management for 24 years. He moved on to Granite Rock, starting as Credit manager, moved over to Worker's Compensation Administrator, and ultimately retired in 2009.

A pet project of Dan and Vickie's is organizing food for the Orchestra to eat during the break in the rehearsal before the evening performance. This is understandably very popular with the musicians and fosters conversation and camaraderie between them that they would not have otherwise.


